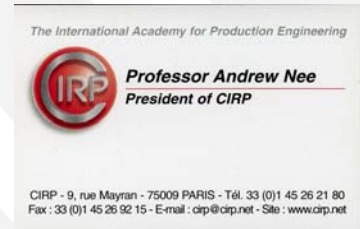


Professor Andrew YC Nee

CIRP President 2011 - First Singaporean and Ethnic Chinese in the World



Prof Andrew NEE has been elected President of the Paris-based International Academy for Production Engineering (CIRP) with effect from 1 September 2011. He is the first Singaporean and ethnic Chinese in the world to hold the position in the 60 years of history of CIRP since its establishment in 1951. He is also the first in the ASEAN region to become Fellow of the Academy. CIRP is the foremost international academy dedicated to production engineering research.
